On the first day of the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year, The California Commission on the Status of Women and Girls commends Governor Jerry Brown and the Leaders of the California State Legislature, Speaker Toni G. Atkins and Senate Pro-Tem Kevin De Leon for their steadfast leadership in crafting a budget that provides new investments for California's future and renewed funding for the Commission.

This Funding allocation of \$500,000 and 2.1 new staff positions, coupled with the spending authority of up to \$374,000 for private donations to the Women and Girls Fund will ensure that our Commission remains positioned as a critical catalyst for action. Our goals have remained consistent over our 50 years – always working toward equality for women and girls in the State; driving decisive change through policy and program development, education, collaboration, advocacy and strategic partnerships.
